



## BHC 2010 Fees – Senior grades

<b>Seniors (&gt;18yrs)</b>	<b>\$500<sup>#</sup></b>	A minimum <b>\$150 must be paid</b> at sign on or prior to 1 <sup>st</sup> March 2010  <b>All Fees and costs must be paid in full by 16 May 2010</b> unless arrangements are made with BHC's Treasurer and approved by the BHC Executive
<b>Seniors (≤18yrs)</b>	<b>\$400<sup>#</sup></b>	
<b>Students (full time)</b>	<b>\$400<sup>#</sup></b>	

<sup>#</sup> Discounted complete season fee based on fulfilling the minimum Volunteer/Fundraising Component (refer pg2).

Players **taking on a Volunteer Functional Role** are deemed to have fulfilled the Volunteer / Fundraising Component and **are eligible for further reduced fees as advertised on pg2.**

Goal Keepers providing their own playing gear are eligible for a \$150 discount off the applicable fee.

Players and families with difficulty paying can make arrangements with BHC's Treasurer.

<sup>#</sup> Players can elect not to participate in volunteer or fundraising activities by **paying an additional \$100.** Families, with more than one playing member pay a single Volunteer/Fundraising Component based on the most senior registered player (refer example on pg2).

### BHC Fees cover:

- Hockey Queensland Registration and Injury Insurance (Policy available on website);
- Match ground fees and Training ground fees;
- IHA Umpiring levy (umpires get paid/game by IHA);
- Canteen & Bar duty payments (BHC are required to staff the IHA canteen/bar every 3-4 weeks during season);
- Volunteer discount incentives (rewarding those who get involved – *refer over for details*);
- Bellbowrie Sport & Recreation Club ground fees;
- Training and match equipment (balls, first aid, cones, bibs, goalie gear etc);
- Playing shirts & clothing; and
- Trophies, advertising and administration expenses.

*Note: BHC may only be able to part-subsidise the costs of out of season fitness activities.*

## Minimum Volunteer / Fundraising Component

Player Category	Fundraising / Volunteer Requirement	
	<u>Either:</u> Fundraise / Volunteer equivalent hours #	<u>OR:</u> pay an additional
Senior grades	\$120/family	\$100/family
Junior grades (U11 – U15)	\$70/family	\$60/family
Hin2H or Minkey	\$50/family	\$30/family

# Volunteer / fundraising requirements apply on a “family” basis rather than an individual player basis and are based on the senior most registered player in the family.

# **Table 1** provides guidance on the equivalent fundraising effort / volunteer hours.

# Players fulfilling an advertised Volunteer Functional Role are deemed to have fulfilled the Fundraising / Volunteer Requirement and are eligible for the **fee discounts advertised in Table 2**.

### Example

A family comprising **two senior and two junior players** must fundraise/volunteer the equivalent of \$120 or pay \$100 in addition to playing fees. Alternatively one of the senior players can carry out a Functional Role advertised in Table 2 to fulfil this requirement (and further reduce their fees).

<b>Ruby</b>	\$300 and volunteer / fundraising component of Fees	8 Months/Year, >6hrs/wk (>200hrs/yr)	- Development Coordinators (Men, Women, Boys, Girls, Coach, Umpire) - Revenue Officers (Fundraising, Grants, Sponsorship) - Volunteer Management Coordinator, Club Events Coordinator - Communications Officer, Administration Officer
<b>Sapphire</b>	\$250 and volunteer / fundraising component of Fees	In Season, 4-6hrs/wk (100-200hrs/yr)	- Team Coach - Canteen Coordinator, BHC Registrar
<b>Emerald</b>	\$100 and volunteer / fundraising component of Fees	In Season, 2-4hrs/wk (50-100hrs/yr)	- Team Roles (Manager, Assistant Coach, Club Fitness Trainer (Unpaid)) - Hook in2 Hockey / Minkey (Coach, Coordinator) - Communications Roles (Website, Newsletters, Manager Notices, Publicity) - Administration Roles (BHC Bellbowrie Sport & Rec Club Representative)
<b>Topaz</b>	Volunteer / fundraising component of Fees	In Season, 1-2hrs/wk (25-50hrs/yr)	- Major Revenue Raiser (Coordination of a Major Fundraiser, Sponsorship Deal, Grant Application) - Operational Officer (Equipment, Uniforms, Trophies, Minutes Secretary) - Event Organiser (Trivia Night, Presentation Night, Supporters Day) - IHA umpire

NOTE: To be eligible for the above discounts you must apply, and be appointed by the BHC Executive Committee. Discounts are cumulative (ie if you perform more than one role you are eligible for all discounts applicable to those roles).
